- Have I included setup of my Traffic Catcher Site (TCS) page to provide additional information to my potential customer base?

TCS pages and Member Directory listings are provided to you at no charge and are a primary benefit of your membership. In addition to reaching potential customers, you can use your membership listing to offer unique sales opportunities or coupons, to tie your social media pages and postings directly to your membership listing, and to highlight your businesses involvement with the community through work or sponsorship of non-profits in the area.
