2018 Awards Banquet - Sweetheart Ball

The program will begin with cocktails at 5:30 p.m. At 6:00 p.m. we will start dinner provided by Main Street Market, Panama. It is no secret people would rather be doing things like running a marathon in the desert or swimming in Prairie Rose Lake in the middle of February, than seeing the dentist. With this in mind, White Pine Dental Group has embraced the idea of creating efficient appointments and less visits to the dentist. We invested in cutting edge technology by purchasing a Computer Aided Design/ Computer Aided Manufacture or CAD/CAM.

CAD/CAM technology has been around for the last 15-20 years. However, it has only been in the last 3-6 years that the technology has become practical and patient friendly. CAD/CAM gives us the ability to create crowns, bridges, implant abutments and many other restorations in office. This means we now are capable of completing a majority of the above mentioned procedures during the same appointment versus the traditional way of completing in two appointments.

The CAD/CAM equipment is composed of an intraoral scanner, computer, and a mill. We will use making a crown as an example to illustrate. The intraoral scanner allows us to take digital impressions of the tooth we worked on. The computer takes this information and assists the dentist in designing the crown. When we like the design, we finalize and send it to our mill. The mill will take about 15-20 minutes to cut a block to the exact design of the crown, much like a 3D printer. A few final touches (staining, glazing, etc.) to naturalize the crown and then it is cemented in the mouth and the patient walks out of the office with a new crown in one appointment.

The primary benefits help create a better patient experience. First, rather than two appointments in which patients have to take time off work, we can complete it in one appointment (about 2 hours). Secondly, it is a lot cleaner and causes less stress for the patient. No longer do we need to use the impression goo. So, the patients are not gagging on impression goo, getting it all over their faces, or having discomfort from the metal trays digging in to their cheeks. Third, it prevents the patient from having to have a temporary crown which could possibly come off before the next appointment. Fourth, the crowns are custom fitted to your mouth as you sit in the chair. This means when you leave the office the crown will look, feel, and be right.

White Pine Dental Group, formerly Markham Family Dental, is a family oriented dental practice located at 2105 Pine Street in Harlan, IA. Dr. Phil Markham, Dr. Logan Veath, and our team perform a myriad of procedures. These procedures include fillings, crowns, bridges, cleanings, root canals, oral surgery, and many more.
