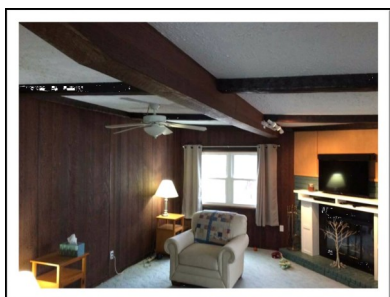
# Featured Member: Fahn Interior Design - Heroes Come in Many Forms

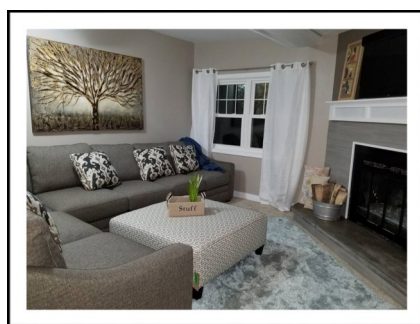
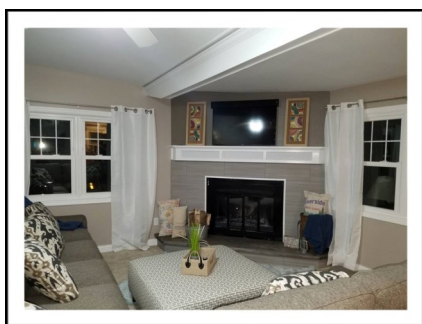
Often the feeling of defeat settles in quickly and those shows on HGTV seem only possible in the magical world of television.

### Roasted Asparagus

Ingredients: 3 lbs. asparagus, trimmed; 1/2 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil; less than 1/4 tsp. salt and freshly ground pepper.

1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees.
2. Toss asparagus with oil on a baking sheet with sides or in a large roasting pan.
3. Spread in a single layer and season with salt and pepper.
4. Roast asparagus, uncovered, for 15-25 minutes, or until tender. Serve hot or at room temperature.
